
THE UNRAVELING



My Story of Faith, Forgiveness, and a Family Restored


Connection. Belonging. Love.




Q & A with Judi Logan

This is such a powerful story of hope! Who do you want to read this and get that hope?

Everyone! I want anyone and everyone to read this book, especially if they're tired of looking for answers or hope in all the wrong places and nothing seems to fill the void. It's not about religion, my friends, it's about a relationship with God. Only He can fill that void and give you true hope and meaning in your life.

What made you want to write your story?

To be honest, I didn't want to write it. I've had several people tell me that I need to write my story or that God spoke to them to tell me to start writing because He has big plans for me (and they didn't even know my story). The more confirmations I received, the more I believed that God truly wanted me to tell my story.






As you wrote, did you ever feel like you didn't want to keep going?

Most definitely! I've had plenty of times when I wanted to quit. I doubted myself and my abilities. The little voices in your head start to tell you that no one would want to read your story or that you don't matter or that you won't make an impact. These are all negative things that the enemy will use to keep you from reaching your destination.

Q & A with Judi Logan

Tell us about how you encouraged yourself to share the complete story.

I wanted to be obedient to what God had called me to do. He said that if I don't do it, He'll find someone else. I didn't want to forsake my opportunity. It was tough though; I stopped writing several times because I felt that I wasn't qualified to write my story. The enemy kept whispering in my ears that my story doesn't matter. God would bring people around to tell me just the right things to encourage me. I would constantly listen to podcasts and sermons, and it felt like they were directly talking to me. Then I'd get motivated again. I also had to keep reminding myself that someone out there is waiting on my obedience, to give them the boldness and courage to tell their story, too.



How did your family support you in writing this?

My husband and children were very supportive. They would tell me that my story is like a movie. They would get excited and blurt out actors' and actresses' names who could play different parts. It was funny! Although they know my story, they would encourage me and say that they can't wait to see the final product in their hands and actually read the book. My biological mom completely supported me from the start. She said that people have to know that God is real and that only He can turn any kind of situation around when you give it to Him. She was happy that I included her side of the story, no matter how painful it was for her to retell it. My stepfather, who I was raised believing was my uncle (my biological mom's husband), was supportive as well. They agreed that my story will bring hope to the lost and hurting world.

Q&A with Judi Logan

One of the themes is forgiveness. When do you think you were ready to start forgiving some of the struggles and people in your life?

This is a loaded question. Looking back, I thought that I had forgiven all three sets of parents at one point. But then, different things would come up in conversations, and I would cry and be hurt all over again, because there was still lingering pain.

An example I can equate this to is when a porcelain vase breaks, you can likely put the bigger pieces back together again. You might even be able to glue in the smaller ones too, but what about the tiny shards? The ones you can barely see with the naked eye. Those are left behind and continue to cause pain. When I developed my relationship with God and found my identity in Him, I discovered that I hadn't forgiven myself for all the trauma that happened in my life. When I was able to finally forgive myself, I was then able to truly forgive everybody else. The forgiveness and redemption that God has shown and given me is why and how I am able to share my story today.




How can others forgive similar challenges?

I understand that not everyone is a Christian, and I understand that not all will want to follow Christ. But let me ask this question: has anything else worked for you? Are you still living in unforgiveness and bondage? Are you still angry or hurt thinking about your situation? The only answer I can give to anyone is to turn to Jesus and give all their cares and burdens to Him. He says in Matthew 11:28-30, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." When you're yoked (or bound) together with Christ, Jesus is the only answer to help your unforgiveness.

Q & A with Judi Logan

At the end of the book, you have clearly become the person you were meant to be, which took a lot of strength. What do you do daily to keep pushing forward after such a tough start and remember who you are?

I give myself daily to God. What I mean by this is every morning when I wake up, the first thing I do is my devotionals and prayer. I give my attention to God first; I thank Him for giving me another opportunity to live and serve Him, and I spend time in the Bible reading His Word. During every meal, I pray and give thanks for the food. Throughout the day, I give thanks to God for all the other things he brings to my life, big and small. For example, a close parking space or good weather or unexpected blessings like friends giving my family money, which has happened several times. God spoke to their hearts to bless us. And at night before going to bed, I give thanks to God for a great day and ask for good rest. I give my final hours before I fall asleep to Him.



What is the big message you want readers to get from your story?

The biggest message I want readers to get from my story is that there is always hope, they just need to know where to look. Many people have low self esteem because they are looking for approval or acceptance in all the wrong places. Or they think they can handle difficult situations on their own, until they're in over their heads and get swallowed up whole. You are not alone, and nobody has to be alone in walking this life. When you allow God into your life, He will walk with you, and He will never leave you or forsake you. He already accepts you the way you are; you just need to ask Him into your life.
